Wednesday Readers:

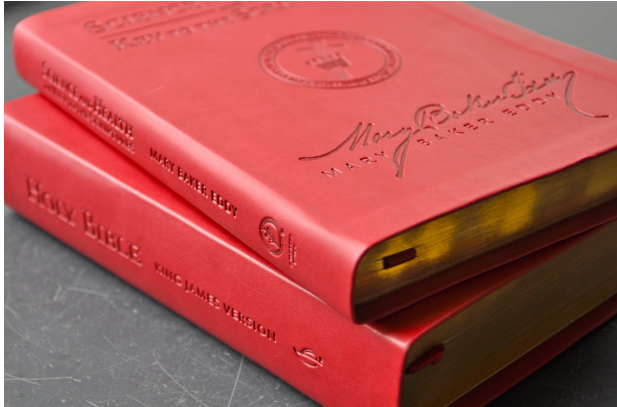
- Prepare 3 Wednesday readings during the semester, as well as lead the testimony meeting <3

- ★ Provide welcoming and loving environment in which new members feel comfortable

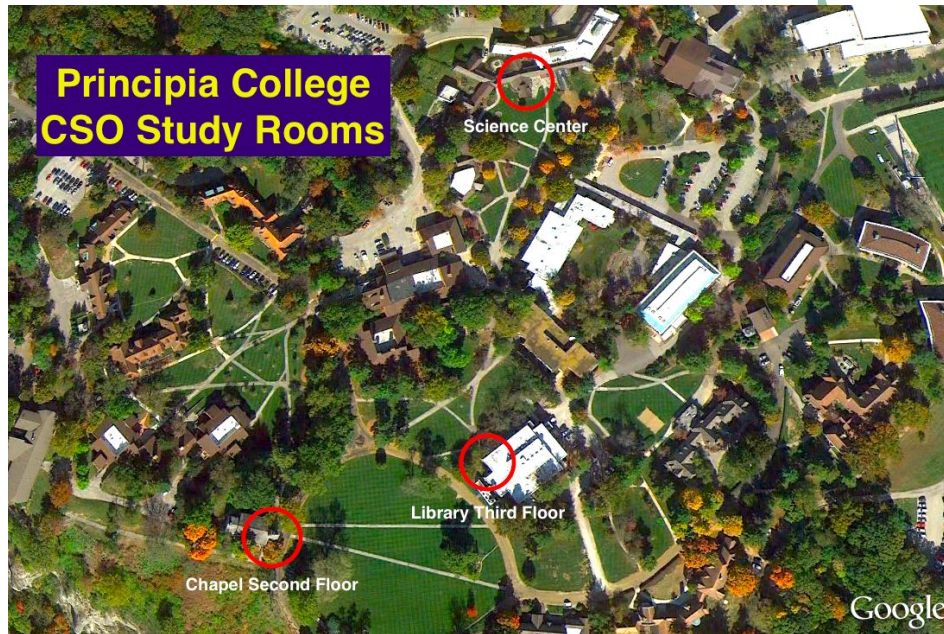




Study Room Committee





